

SUMMARY OF RUNOFF ELECTIONS

Statewide Races

Lt. Governor: **Mike Collier** won the Democratic runoff, defeating **Michelle Beckley** 55% to 45%. Collier will face incumbent **Dan Patrick (R)** in a rematch of the 2018 Lt. Governor race, where **Patrick** won by a vote of 51% to 47%.

State Comptroller: **Glenn Hegar** will face the winner of the Democratic runoff, **Janet Dudding** on election day. In the runoff, **Dudding** defeated **Angel Luis Vega** by way of a 62% to 38% margin.

Attorney General: **Ken Paxton** prevailed over challenger **George P. Bush** in the Republican runoff by receiving 68% of the vote, compared to Bush's 32%. In the Democratic runoff, **Rochelle Garcia** of the Rio Grande Valley secured victory over **Joe Jaworski**, 63% to 37%.

Land Commissioner: The Republican runoff between ophthalmologist **Dawn Buckingham** and **Tim Westley** was won by Buckingham, winning nearly 69% to Westley's 31%. On the Democratic side, King Ranch Descendent **Jay Kleberg** defeated **Sandragrace Martinez** 53% to 47%.

Railroad Commissioner: Democratic candidate **Luke Warford** will face Republican incumbent **Wayne Christian** in November. **Christian** defeated challenger **Sarah Stogner** in the Republican runoff, 65% to 35%.

Texas Senate

SD 24: Republican **Pete Flores**, a former game warden, won the runoff against **Raul Reyes**, 59% to 41%. **Flores** will face Democrat **Kathy Jones-Hospod**, an engineer based out of Cedar Park, Texas.

Texas House of Representatives

HD 12: College Station Republican **Kyle Kacal**, a former county Farm Bureau president, defeated **Ben Bius** in the runoff election by garnering nearly 58% of the vote.

HD 17: With 99% of the votes counted, this district that includes Bastrop and Caldwell Counties has **Stan Gerdes** over Bastrop County Judge **Paul Pape** by just over 330 votes, 51% to 49%.

HD 60: The incumbent **Glenn Rogers**, a veterinarian, leads challenger **Mike Olcott** by 700 votes, and this race has not yet been called. The vote currently stands 52% to 48%.

HD 84: **Carl Tepper** prevailed with 59% of the vote in this Lubbock, Texas area seat. **David Glasheen**, a local attorney received 42% of the vote. There is no Democrat challenger. Tepper's wife, Robyn, serves as District Coordinator for State Senator Charles Perry.

HD 85: In this rice country runoff, **Stan Kitzman** won the election over incumbent **Phil Stephenson**, 58% to 42%. **Kitzman** is from Waller County and is a retired public school teacher.

HD 91: Incumbent **Stephanie Klick** again will fill HD 91's seat in the Texas Legislature, defeating **David Lowe** 54% to 46%. There is no Democratic challenger in the general election.

U.S. Congressional Races-Texas

TX-28: This contentious Democratic runoff between **Henry Cuellar** and **Jessica Cisneros** is too close to call. Currently, **Cuellar** leads by 177 votes in this South Texas race over the progressive **Cisneros**, 50.2% to 49.8%. The winner of this Democratic runoff will face Republican **Cassy Garcia**, who formerly served as a regional field representative for the Texas Commissioner of Agriculture.
